

**PROCLAMATION
OF DISASTER IN THE COUNTY OF LAKE**

In accordance with the Illinois Emergency Management Act (20 ILCS 3305), I, Aaron Lawlor, Chairman of the Lake County Board, do hereby proclaim that a disaster exists in Lake County due to severe widespread flooding throughout the County expected to reach record flood stage for the Des Plaines River, Fox River and Chain O' Lakes. Many communities are also experiencing significant localized flooding. Initial assessments include reports of potential large-scale damage to residential and commercial properties. Additional reports indicate widespread flooding has compromised roadways and public works infrastructure.


Michael Dacey, Coordinator of the Lake County Emergency Management Agency, is ordered to proceed with all haste to bring said emergency to a rapid conclusion for the best interest of the residents of Lake County, pursuant to the Illinois Emergency Management Act, 20 ILCS 3305, as amended, and the Lake County Emergency Management Agency Ordinance, most recently amended April 10, 2007.

This Proclamation is effective 10:00 p.m. July 12, 2017 and shall expire July 20, 2017, unless extended by the Lake County Board.
