# What is Youth Stat?

**Youth Stat is a school-based intervention program that seeks to reduce justice involvement and improve health and wellness outcomes of students from elementary to post-secondary education.**

## Program Goal

**Improve school engagement and academic performance among program-involved youth.**



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# Student Participant Criteria

- 1. A high risk for school disengagement and/or juvenile or criminal justice involvement**
- 2. Poor academic performance, specifically (D's and F's) in reading and math**
- 3. Multiple suspensions and/or expulsions**
- 4. Chronic truancy and absences**
- 5. Exposure to trauma or violence**
